- b. K4DMS will be participating in the Fall School Club Roundup during the week of October 18th. They will operate on 20 meters most of the time, except from 4:10-4:20 each day when they will be on 146.580 simplex and then again from 5:50-6:00 Tuesday through Thursday.

Article VI of club bylaws.

Section I: Members more than two (2) months delinquent in dues payment will be considered not in good standing and shall lose all voting privileges. A member may be reinstated during a four (4) month period by payment of all delinquent and current dues before February 1. After this period membership shall be terminated automatically and a new application for membership required. Termination for any other reason shall require two thirds of membership balloting.
