ARES NET REPORT

At each of our Lowcountry ARES net sessions we share a short training topic. A recent session referred to the need to practice. Practice is very important, hence the saying 'practice makes perfect'. We get so used to operating in a specific way that many hams cannot remember how to configure their radios for new frequencies or modes. The U.S. Military recognized this same problem a few years ago. They realized that their practice did not mirror what they To overcome this were facing in real combat. problem, they instituted a 'practice as you fight' mentality into all phases of operations. This has allowed our military to be successful in many aspects, especially in the areas of unusual operations. So how does this apply to hams?

Hams in South Carolina face many challenges. Rust and corrosion are constant enemies. When was the last time you checked and set up your equipment? When was the last time you configured your radios for a low power, simplex frequency, and power conservation mode? Have you ever practiced passing an amateur radio message? Even more important, are you familiar with the ICS-213 form message used during disasters? If not, you will need to get trained and practice!

A good source of practice is the Lowcountry ARES Net. The net meets for 20 minutes every Sunday
