EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

November is the last month of Hurricane season. Lot's of named storms this season and still a few weeks left. Do Not let your guard down just yet.

Clocks fall back one hour on November 6, 2021 so the Sunday ARES net will start at 20:00 local time, see who forgot to change their clocks. With the time change kids will be at bus stops in the dark in the mornings and maybe near dark when they are coming home. Watch out for the kids and school buses.

I had a conference call with South Carolina Emergency Management and the Section Emergency Coordinator. Lots of new classes are coming on line now with COVID under better control. Also some thought is being given to having regional training instead of traveling to Columbia. The leadership wants everyone to know how much you are appreciated and what you do for the local area.

Start thinking about how we would man shelters both in your home county and maybe counties more inland where evacuees could be taken. Also prepare for post-event shelters, after the event may require shelters for people returning to the area only to find out they have nothing to stay in still standing. Remember some disasters take weeks/months for recovery not just days.

Other areas could be hospitals losing communications and would require hams to provide communications between floors or with other hospitals. Maybe your church may need communications with other community churches or relief agencies. All of these NGOs or groups could need assistance communicating. Remember normal systems – cell phones, internet, etc – may be overloaded or not usable. The internet may fail and EMS/Police/Fire may also need back-up communications like during Hugo. Stay prepared and ask for training if you feel you need some. There are people available to help you, learning before the disaster is better than learning during the disaster.

Lastly, expect some different kinds of ARES training on the Sunday net. In this area we seem to concentrate on hurricanes but other natural disasters can and do occur. We also have man made disasters equally as devastating. Stay prepared because it's not if something will happen it's when something happens.
