EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Two months of Hurricane Season are over, but we still have until November 30th. The Accuweather experts have predicted an increase in named storms in the Atlantic Basin. Initial estimates were for 11 to 15 named storms, increasing to 13 to 17 named storms. We have already had 4 named storms so far this season and the mid-August to October time frame is historically the busiest with September 10 the peak of activity. So, stay alert and have Plan A, B, C, and maybe even a D just in case a storm heads this way.

Earthquakes are also increasing in numbers in the area. We do sit near a fault line and earthquakes give little to no warning, so please, please stay ready and prepared to assist your community. Earthquakes do disrupt many underground systems especially water, sewers, gas lines, phone lines, pipelines in general, and drop trees which only fall on power lines. Be prepared to evacuate via different than normal routes as roads and culverts may be damaged or gone. Also, ALL bridges and overpasses are ruled "UNSAFE" until inspected so be careful. And watch out for native creatures that have had their usual habitat damaged and are looking for a new place to live.

Check your "Go Kits" supplies and refresh as necessary. Medications, lotions, snacks, and batteries can go bad and are NOT useable. You should keep your radio batteries charged and maybe get some "clamshell" battery cases for AA and AAA batteries. Flashlights need batteries as well. Please label your equipment, unfortunately you set a piece of gear down and accidentally leave it or are called away, your Yaesu FT-60 HT looks just like my Yaesu FT-60 HT so please label your equipment so it can be returned to you safely without confusion. I use my FCC Call Sign on my gear, just a suggestion. Plus, if labelled I know how to return it to you.

Stay Alert and always ask yourself "What If?"
