EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

[editor's note: This article was submitted four storms ago (last week).] September is the peak of Hurricane Season. The peak is September 10, 2023. There is a depression in the Gulf of Mexico that will impact Florida by Tuesday or Wednesday before September but watch the track Charleston could get more rain and winds. The coast of Africa is starting to get active as well, keep watching for severe weather. Remember Hugo was the fourth storm in line, not the first storm in line.

Check your supplies in case a storm does come this way. Stores will run out of items quickly so get a head of the game by checking now. Bread will stay good in your freezer so get a spare loaf. Paper products last for a very long time, doing dishes when water is restricted can be easy if paper plates and plastic eating utensils are available for throwing away. Get that extra stock of garbage bags now to store trash later and the big trash bags make usable emergency rain ponchos too.

Watch for little kids and school buses now that school is back in session. Plan to leave earlier to

allow longer travel times because of buses and school. After-school events will be happening too so be careful in school zones and around school buses.

Check your Amateur gear out now. After a severe weather event branches from trees fall on antenna's make sure you have a ground crew for tower work, ask for help with antenna work the Club has many members just waiting for a chance to help with your antenna project.

Check with your local schools and ask if they have an emergency plan, you may be able to help them out and keep kids safe at the same time. Remember new school buildings are not made like the old days of all blocks and cement, they have more glass and other energy efficient systems. Evacuating many folks from school needs coordination both controlling students and parents arriving to pick them up before a disaster hits.

Earthquakes do occur in South Carolina and have been more frequent lately. Just because they have all been minor does not mean we are safe, historically the Low Country is overdue for a damaging quake so stay prepared.
