# **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS**

September is over and now starting October. We still have 2 months until the end of Hurricane season. The letter R has been used and according to the weather service the Atlantic is ahead in named storms for this time in the season. We are not over the predictions.

The Low Velo bike ride in November is another opportunity to test your ability to operate outside of your comfort zone and established radio shack. Sign up, support the Club activities, and learn some new skills. For experienced operators take a new

operator and show them some tricks you have mastered already.

October means Coastal Carolina Fair is in town. Take an HT with you because cell phone coverage can be spotty. The Exchange Park and vendors bring in extra portable cell repeaters but bandwidth is always critical. No problem with Amateur Radio. Also darkness comes sooner look out for kids especially the Trick or Treaters on Halloween.

Check your vehicles out. Colder weather impacts battery starting power and other parts of a vehicle. Start keeping seasonal clothes or shoes in your vehicle as New York City found out flooded streets make travel impossible and walking may be required. Some vehicles have the air intakes at bumper/grill level not on top of the engine; flooding out your engine is easier than you think in deep water. Remember "Turn around, Don't drown."

On October 4, 2023 at 1420 hours the FEMA and FCC will be testing the Emergency Alert System. The notifications will be sent to cell phones and commercial radio and TV stations. This is an annual test so expect it. (I will send out a blast before the event).

Emergency Management Area 3 is doing their Simulated Emergency Test on October 4, 2023. They have a Winlink station and want to test its coverage so if you are Winlink capable please reply to them.

October is ARRL Simulated Emergency Test (SET) month and Charleston County will be doing this test on October 21, 2023 (Third Saturday) on the Yorktown. Please come out, bring an HT and its user manual, and be prepared to demonstrate the use of emergency communications. I do have a plan and your inputs and participation will be fun.
