The number of storms predicted will change as the season progresses but here is the starting predictions and site to keep up to date:

- 13-19 Named storms
- 6-10 Hurricane
- 3-5 Major Hurricanes.

We will have a Get On The Air (GOTA) station. We're still looking for a GOTA Captain and operators. This is a terrific opportunity to show off Ham Radio and be an ambassador for CARS. The GOTA station will be in full view of the public and operators can invite passerby to have a seat and make contacts. A big change this year is that every logged contact at the GOTA station counts as points for the club!

Please show up! Field Day is the premier event for the ARRL and epitomizes the spirit of ham radio. All club members are welcome anytime during the event and it's a fantastic opportunity to meet and socialize. There will be plenty of good food and soft drinks throughout. We will place a sign-up sheet on WA4USN.org for operating times, but if you're there and want to operate, we'll get you on the air. As a CW operator, I can tell you this is the best opportunity to build CW skills, and it only comes around once a year. SPECIAL PROJECTS

Most of the APRS nodes on the CARS and HEARTS system consist of a 2m FM transceiver and a Kantronics KPC-9612 TNC (terminal node controller, a type of modem). The KPC-9612 runs in native digipeater mode.

In order to interface with the internet, the node on the USS Yorktown also has a Raspberry Pi to process packets. The KPC-9612 offloads all processing to the Pi using the KISS protocol.

The Pi runs a software package called APRX that uses the USB serial port to speak KISS to the TNC and the ethernet port to talk to the internet. While the APRX package is capable of routing traffic between multiple radios, we only have one connected. APRX also has a library of beacon messages.

You can set up your own APRX node using a TNC and APRX – if using a Ubuntu Linux build, aprx is available through *apt-get* to install. If you don't have a TNC, you can experiment with a soundcard interface like a SignalLink USB and UZ7HO's software *soundmodem* program.
